

Scholarships for Class 10 (Madhyamik) Pass-Outs (West Bengal, 2025)

- **HDFC Bank Parivartan ECSS Programme (School Students, Class 11–12)** – Merit-cum-Need scholarship by HDFC Bank Parivartan. **Eligibility:** Indian students (all categories) currently in Class 11–12 (2025–26), passed the previous exam with $\geq 55\%$, annual family income $\leq ₹2.5$ L (preference to needy). **Benefit:** One-time award of ₹18,000 for school students (Class 7–12) ¹. **Dates:** For the 2024–25 cycle, applications opened earlier in 2024 and closed on 31 Dec 2024 ². (The 2025–26 cycle is expected to run on a similar timeline.)
- **EY (Ernst & Young) NextGen Edu Scholarship** – National scholarship for students entering Class 11. **Eligibility:** Indian students in Class 11, any board, who scored $\geq 60\%$ in Class 10; annual family income $\leq ₹3$ L ³. (Open to all genders; preference to applicants from select states including West Bengal ⁴.) **Benefit:** ₹15,000 one-time grant towards Class 11 tuition/fees ⁵. **Dates:** 2024–25 applications closed on June 26, 2024 ⁶; the 2025–26 round is expected around mid-2025 (likely May–Jun).
- **JM Sethia Merit Scholarship Scheme** (JM Sethia Charitable Trust, Kolkata) – Aid for meritorious students. **Eligibility:** Students enrolled in Class 11–12 (Category B) must have passed Class 10 with $\geq 75\%$ aggregate ⁷ (and admitted to 11th). Annual family income $\leq ₹1.2$ L (for EWS 20% quota); 20% seats reserved for special-need/EWS. **Benefit:** ₹500 per month for 2 years (Classes 11–12) ⁸. (Higher categories for undergraduate.) **Dates:** 2024–25 applications closed July 31, 2024 ⁹; the 2025 round will likely open after 2025 exam results (around mid-2025).
- **Aditya Birla Capital Scholarship** (AB Capital Foundation) – One-time scholarship for school and college students. **Eligibility:** Students in Class 9–12 who scored $\geq 60\%$ in their previous exam; annual family income $\leq ₹6$ L ¹⁰. (Open nationwide, girls are given preference.) **Benefit:** One-time cash award up to ₹60,000 (often $\approx ₹12,000$ for Class 11 as of 2024) ¹¹. **Dates:** 2024–25 applications were open until Oct 15, 2024 ¹²; the 2025–26 applications are expected in late 2025.
- **National Talent Search Examination (NTSE)** – National merit scholarship exam for high-performing Class 10 students. **Eligibility:** Indian nationals in Class 10 (typically must have $\geq 60\%$ in Class 9) ¹³. **Benefit:** Scholars receive ₹1,250/month during Class 11–12 ¹⁴ (continuing ₹2,000/month in higher studies). **Dates:** Stage-I applications generally open around Aug–Sep each year; for 2025: forms due Sept 2025, exam ~Nov 2025 ¹⁵ (final results in Aug/Sept 2026). The exact dates vary by state.
- **West Bengal Pre-Matric Scholarship (Minorities)** – State scholarship for minority community students in Class 1–10. **Eligibility:** Domiciled West Bengal students from Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain or Parsi communities; pursuing Class 9–10 with $\geq 50\%$ marks in previous exam ¹⁶; family income $\leq ₹2$ L per annum. **Benefit:** Annual stipend up to ₹11,000 (for Class 9–10) ¹⁶. **Dates:** 2024–25 portal typically opens late 2024/early 2025; deadline for 2024–25 was 28 Feb 2025 ¹⁷. (Likely similar in 2025–26.)

- **West Bengal Post-Matric Scholarship (Minorities)** – State scholarship for minority community students in Class 11–12 and higher. **Eligibility:** West Bengal domiciles from the six notified minorities; studying 11th–PG/PhD with $\geq 50\%$ in last exam ¹⁸; annual family income $\leq ₹2$ L. **Benefit:** Stipend up to ₹16,500 per year (or as per actual fees) ¹⁸. **Dates:** 2024–25 applications closed on 28 Feb 2025 ¹⁷; 2025–26 cycle expected similar (open late 2024, close Feb 2025).
- **West Bengal Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (Minorities, Technical/Professional)** – For minority students in professional courses. **Eligibility:** Domiciled West Bengal students from the six minorities; enrolled in a professional/technical UG/PG course (e.g. engineering, medicine, law, CA, etc.) in West Bengal $\geq 50\%$ in last qualifying exam; income $\leq ₹2.5$ L ¹⁹. **Benefit:** Scholarship up to ₹33,000 per year (subject to actual fees) ¹⁹. **Dates:** 2024–25 applications were due 28 Feb 2025 ²⁰. (Renewed annually; check WBMDFC portal in late 2024.)
- **West Bengal Talent Support Stipend Programme (Minorities)** – Stipend for minority students with low scores. **Eligibility:** West Bengal domiciled students of minority communities (as above), studying Class 11 through PhD (regular mode) with $< 50\%$ in last exam; income $\leq ₹2$ L ²¹. **Benefit:** Up to ₹4,900 total stipend for the year ²¹. **Dates:** 2024–25 applications closed 28 Feb 2025 ²⁰; next cycle likely similar.
- **Swami Vivekananda Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (Minorities, West Bengal)** – State merit-cum-means scholarship for minority students from Class 11 onward. **Eligibility:** West Bengal minority students who have just passed Class 10 with high marks (see note); admission to Class 11/12/diploma. Income $\leq ₹2.5$ L; marks $\geq 75\%$ (for higher secondary entry) ²² or $\geq 60\%$ (for other levels) ²³. **Benefit:** Up to ₹60,000 per year (award varies by course) ²³ ²². **Dates:** For 2024–25, deadline was 28 Feb 2025 ²⁴; expect similar in 2025 (portal opens late 2024).
- **Jagadis Bose NSTS Junior Scholarship (West Bengal)** – State talent-search for Class 10 science toppers. **Eligibility:** West Bengal domiciled students who passed Madhyamik in 2025 (or 2024) with $\geq 75\%$, now enrolled in Class 11 (Science stream, with science/math subjects) ²⁵. **Benefit:** ₹1,250 per month for 2 years (total ~₹30,000) during Class 11–12 ²⁶. **Dates:** The Junior NSTS is held every summer; the 2024 test deadline is listed as “TBA” ²⁷. Typically, applications open in May/June and exam in June/July (e.g. July 2024). Watch the JBNSTS website in mid-2025 for exact dates.

Each of the above scholarships is open to *male students* (with no gender restriction noted) in West Bengal. The listed eligibility and benefits are drawn from official sources and scholarship providers ²⁸ ³ ²⁹ ²³. Note that SC/ST/OBC-only schemes have been omitted per instructions. Always verify current details and deadlines on the official scholarship portals or announcing agencies before applying.

Scholarships for Class 11 (West Bengal, 2025)

Various scholarship schemes are available to West Bengal students who have passed the Madhyamik (Class 10) exam and enrolled in Class 11. These include state-run programs (for SC/ST/OBC, minorities, girls, etc.) and central or private awards. For example, the West Bengal Post-Matric Scholarship for SC/ST provides maintenance allowances (e.g. ₹230/month for Class 11 day scholars) ¹, and the state Swami Vivekananda MCM scholarship (for minority students) grants ₹1,000 per month to eligible Class 11–12 students ². In the table below we list each scholarship's name, eligibility, award amount, and application dates, based on official guidelines and scholarship portals ¹ ².

Another example is the Jagadis Bose National Science Talent Search (JBNSTS) Junior Scholarship: Class 11 science students who scored $\geq 75\%$ in Madhyamik can receive ₹1,250 per month for two years (plus a ₹2,500/year book grant for girls) ³. Similarly, unmarried girls aged 13–18 enrolled in Classes 8–12 can get the Kanyashree annual scholarship of ₹500/month ⁴. The table below compiles these and other schemes. For each scholarship, the eligibility (including marks and income limits), award amount, and application start/end dates are given (links point to official sources or verified scholarship sites).
